



## Petaluma Bounty Hunters Volunteer Needs

- Harvesters:
  - No experience necessary
  - No minimum commitment, sign up for gleans as it works for you
  - Each glean lasts usually around 2-3 hours
- Harvest Lead Coordinators:
  - Completed at least three gleans
  - Train and shadow with Bounty Hunters Coordinator
  - Arrives early to gleaning event, checks in Harvesters
  - Lead at least one glean per month, each glean usually takes 5 hours including prep and follow up
  - Communication and coordination with Volunteer Coordinator and other staff
- Drivers:
  - Must have a current driver's license and proof of insurance on file with Bounty Hunters
  - Large capacity vehicle best, such as a truck, van, station wagon or SUV
  - Varying commitment levels ranging from on-call to weekly shifts, each shift usually lasts ~2 hours
- Volunteer Coordinator/Logistics Master:
  - Schedules gleans after property has been visited and okayed by Property Scout
  - Sends out invite email to volunteer harvesters
  - Confirms minimum number of harvesters met and sends directions to location
  - Confirms all Harvesters have Volunteer Waiver on file
- Property Scout:
  - Go to farms or gardens to confirm ripeness of produce, safety guidelines and the property meet requirements for a successful glean
  - Commitment requires a minimum of 2 visits per month, each visit lasts ~2 hours
- Office Support
  - Can work from home
  - Varying commitment levels
