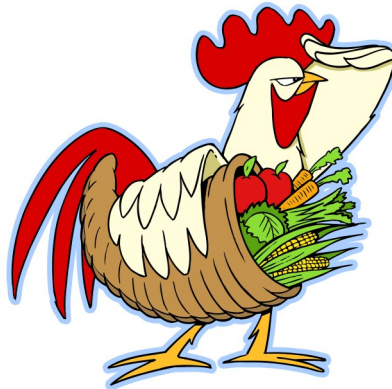


# Three Easy Ways to Donate your Bounty
