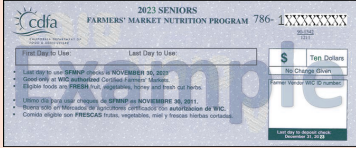




2023 Farmers Market Senior Programs Customer FAQs



What is Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program? (SFMNP)

SFMNP is a federally-funded program that helps low-income seniors buy locally grown produce at authorized certified farmers markets.

Each booklet contains \$50-worth of vouchers. Booklets are limited in quantity and are handed out on a first-come first served basis.

Am I eligible to get SFMNP?

You are eligible if you are

- 60 years old or older and
- income does not exceed 185% of the federal poverty levels
- Have not received SFMNP this year. (One booklet per customer per program year.)

Which vendors will accept SFMNP?

WIC-certified vendors at certified farmers markets.

What can I buy using SFMNP?

Fresh fruits, vegetables, honey, and cut herbs.

Can I get change for SFMNP?

No. Also, SFMNP can't be exchanged for cash or other coupons.

Expiration date for SFMNP

November 30, 2023.

Please be sure to use them by the expiration date! Expired vouchers cannot be redeemed for cash.



Senior Bounty Bucks starts the first week of August 2023! What is it?

Senior Bounty Bucks are extra coupons offered to SFMNP customers. Each Senior Bucks booklet contains \$40 in coupons.

There will be 6 rounds .

Am I eligible to get Senior Bounty Bucks?

Seniors who receive the 2023 SFMNP are eligible.

Which vendors will accept Senior Bounty Bucks?

Any vendor at participating farmers markets who sell eligible products.

What can I buy using Senior Bounty Bucks?

California-grown fresh fruits and vegetables.

Where and when can I get additional rounds?

Can I get change for Senior Bounty Bucks?

No. Also, Senior Bucks can't be exchanged for cash or other coupons.

Expiration date for Senior Bounty Bucks

December 31, 2023.

Please be sure to use them by the expiration date! Expired vouchers cannot be redeemed for cash.

Starting August 2023, pick up Senior Bounty Bucks at the first market of the month at the following farmers markets!

If you receive 2023 SFMNP, you are eligible to get all rounds of 2023 Senior Bounty Bucks. Senior Bounty Bucks will be distributed at the markets listed below. Future dates will be passed out in September and October. Please check in with the market manager for date changes!
