<b>COOL WEATHER CROPS</b>		
<b>Bunching Greens</b>		
Kale-Curly	Winterbor	Standard green curly kale. Winterbor's tall plants bear an abundance of thick, ruffled leaves on slightly curled stems. Productive and cold hardy, flavor becomes sweeter after light frost.
Kale-Dino	Black Magic	Black Magic's leaves are large, wide, straight, and resist curling inward. Uniform dark green color, and upright open habit makes for easy harvest. The plants have sweet flavor and vigorous growth.
Collards	Georgia Southern	Georgia Southern is a large collard plant with a cabbage-like taste. This variety produces bluish-green leaves that can grow up to 36" tall and do not bunch or head like cabbage leaves. These large open heads are great for cooking or freezing. The Georgia Southern collard is vitamin rich, sweet, not bitter, heat tolerant, and frost hardy.
Chard	Bright Lights	Crimson, green, orange, pink, white and yellow petioles are all contained in this well known, colorful chard mix. The leaves are slightly savoyed with a mild taste. Bright Lights can be used in baby mixes at 28 days or bunched at full maturity.
Bunching Greens Mix	One of each	A combination of each of the above.
<b>Heading Brassica</b>		
Broccoli	Deciccio	A traditional Italian heirloom variety producing small, avg. 3–4" main heads projected well above the foliage followed by a large yield of side-shoot spears. Nonuniform in maturity, resulting in a long harvest period. Longer harvest period than other sprouting broccoli varieties, with more variation in shoot size. For spring or fall production. Pinching recommended to encourage heavier side-shoot production.
Cabbage	Katarina/Piccolina	Katarina being a compact, sweet, and fast-growing hybrid with small, round heads, while Piccolina is a mini-pointed cabbage known for its mild, sweet flavor and crunchy texture
Napa Cabbage	China Star	China Star is a little taller and darker than China Gold, weighing an average of 3.6 pounds and measuring 14 inches tall and 6 inches in diameter. Wide, white petioles, creamy yellow interior and a very round, short core gave it high marks. Highly uniform, bolts slowly.
Cauliflower	Amazing/De Jesi	A white, heirloom cauliflower variety originating from Jesi, Italy, known for its sweet, nutty flavor and compact plant with medium-sized heads
Romanesco	Romanesco Italia	A true and popular Italian heirloom with stunning, apple-green heads that are superbly flavored. Its fractal form is a fascinating logarithmic Fibonacci spiral. This variety is widely grown in northern Italy.

<b>Beets</b>		
	Chioggia Guardsmark	This beet has striking crimson and white interior zoning and sweet flavor. Guardsmark strain is selected for more uniform roots than the standard Chioggia beet strain. High resistance to bolting.
	Forono	Uniform, smooth, cylindrical beets make slicing a breeze. Forono's 5"x 2" roots are known for their sweet taste and ease of use for pickling.
	Red Ace	A reliable and adaptable standard red beet. Medium-tall, red-veined greens for bunching. Less uniform and not as attractive as other red hybrids. Also available with NOP-compliant pelleting.
	Yellow Sunrise	Yellow Sunrise is a stunning yellow-fleshed beet with uniform globes and refined taproots. Strong, upright, clean attachments for attractive bunches. Good vigor.
<b>Peas</b>		
Snow Pea	Avalanche	A very popular snow pea due to its tasty, tender, and sweet pods with Afilia type tendrils for harvesting, too. Avalanche produces high quality pods on plants with good yields of 2 pods per node.
Sugar Snap Pea	Sugar Snap Pea	Sugar Snap offers great disease resistance, tall vines, long pods, and excellent flavor. Trellis these tall vines to maximize yields and make harvesting easier. One of our most popular snap peas for its iconic sweetness and large, juicy, crunchy pods.
<b>Herbs</b>		
Basil	Mammolo	Compact, bushy plants are very dense, with large leaves and a classic Italian basil aroma and flavour. They produce extremely high yields and will grow virtually anywhere.
Cilantro	Cruiser	Bolt-resistant variety with uniform plants. Cruiser has a tidier, more upright plant habit and similarly excellent bolt resistance. Large leaves and sturdy stems make it an ideal bunching variety for fresh-market sales.
Dill	Thalia	Slow-bolting dill for bunching and leaf harvest. Uniform habit and blue-green foliage. Wide, flat fronds. Thalia is faster growing and taller (faster to elongate).
Fennel	Florence	The plant grows to about 2 feet tall and bears edible, dill-like foliage. The texture of the bulb is crisp, like celery, and the flavor is similar to fresh anise or licorice.

Parsely	Topit	Improved Giant of Italy type. High leaf mass on thick, upright stems for easier harvest. Compared to the standard parsley Giant of Italy, Topit has larger and darker green leaves, a more uniform plant habit, and sweeter flavor. Very similar to, and from the same breeder as, Pieone. Flat-leaf type. Ht. 18–20".
Scallions	Evergreen hardy white	Exceptionally cold-hardy scallions. Sow early spring through early fall for harvest well into winter. Little or no bulbing, though overwintering may result in bolting in spring.
<b>Tender Greens</b>		
Lettuce	Lettuce Heads Mix	A blend of crisp, tender lettuce varieties, offering a range of textures and flavors.
	Salad Mix	A colorful mix of lettuce varieties, produces sweet, fresh greens perfect for your lettuce bowl
Arugula	Arugula	The standard salad arugula. Slightly lobed leaves with a nutty and peppery flavor.
Pac Choi	Mini	Compact, tender baby bok choy with juicy, mild-flavored stalks and dark green leaves.
Celery	Kelvin	Kelvin is a high quality variety with beautiful dark green stalks and leaves and high knuckle height. Fast to reach harvest size, Kelvin's vigor makes growing marketable celery easy. Excellent tolerance to stressful conditions.
<b>Onions</b>		
	Rosa Di Milano	Bulbs are large to colossal in size and exhibit the true grano shape with distinctly flattened tops. Suited for long storage (6+ months) with thin necks that easily dry down. Strong, bronze-pink skins and great uniformity. An excellent cooking onion, Rossa di Milano contributes an abundance of sweetness and pungency to any cuisine.
	Safrane	Very uniform in size with strong skins and long storage potential. Healthy, vigorous tops with good thrips tolerance. Compared to Patterson, Safrane is a few days later to mature, producing bulbs with greater size potential and similar storage capability. Bulbs are more of an elongated globe shape than Patterson's, which tend to be flatter. Stores 6+ months. Adaptation: 42–50° latitude.
<b>Leeks</b>		
	King Richard	Beautiful full-sized leeks. In favorable soil and culture, the white shanks are over a foot long to the first leaf. Medium-green leaves with full habit. For baby leeks, plant closely (40 seeds/ft.) and harvest at finger size. While not hardy enough for overwintering, they will withstand medium-heavy frost (32° to 20°F/0° to -7°C) without losing their healthy appearance.

<b>Sweet Corn</b>		
	Natural Sweet	Organic main-season super sweet (sh2).  Natural Sweet raises the bar for organic sweet corn quality with delicious, plump ears that taste as good as they look. Positioned high on the plant, the 8" long ears snap with ease. Superior husk protection, good tip fill, and attractive flags. Easily the main-season standard for organic growers. USDA Certified Organic.
<b>Beans</b>		
Bush	Dragon Tongue	Unique flashy heirloom. Avg. 6–6 1/2" flat pods are pale yellow with purple streaks. They are tender, sweet, and good in salads or cooked. Purple disappears upon cooking. Tan seeds with dark speckles. Bush bean.
	Jade	Long, attractive pods. Jade's 6–7", slender, deep green pods are exceptionally tender and delicious. High yielding even under heat or cold stress. Pale green seeds. Bush bean.
<b>Melons</b>		
Melon	Golden Crisp	Easy-to-grow, early-to-mature Asian melon with a succulent sweet flavor and crisp flesh. This gourmet variety originated in Japan and became a commercial success before it was discontinued in the early 1980s. The small, oblong- to pear-shaped fruits weigh about ½ pound each. Smooth, golden skin with incredible sweet, uniquely aromatic white flesh. This delicious, personal-sized melon was almost lost and we are delighted to see it shine once again.
	Diplomat	Earlier Galia Melon with powdery mildew resistance.  Concentrated set of 5–6 lb. fruits is produced on healthy, vigorous vines. Thick, aromatic, sweet green flesh of exceptional eating quality. Small seed cavity. Harvest at full slip, when the skin of the fruit is yellow.
	Ha'Ogen	An excellent tasting, beautiful early melon. Sweet, delicious, extremely juicy muskmelon with thick pale green flesh is pink around the small seed cavity. Very fragrant. Smooth, dark green thin rind turns golden with wide green sutures when ripe.
	Hales Best	A heirloom melon variety grown in the Punjab region of India, producing small, sweet melons with a creamy texture and a flavor similar to honeydew, with a characteristic bright red-orange rind and green stripes.
	Kajari	The flavor is sweet and mild, like that of honeydew. The texture is very creamy. Originating from India, this melon has resistance to powdery mildew.
Watermelon	Crimson Sweet	A pretty, light green melon with dark stripes, Crimson Sweet is famous for its high sugar content and great flavor. Seeds are small and dark. The vines are resistant to anthracnose and fusarium wilt. Give vines plenty of room to run.

	Sugar Baby	Sweet, fine-textured, medium-red flesh. The round, 12 lb., dark green skinned melons grow 8 in. across. GARDEN HINTS: For early fruiting and to overcome a short growing season, plants may be started indoors in peat pots. Water during hot, dry periods.
<b>Cucumbers</b>		
	Armenian	Unique appearance and excellent flavor. Unusual, slightly fuzzy, serpentine fruits are slightly ridged with alternating dark- and light-green stripes. Harvest from 8–18". Despite its shape, Striped Armenian is not a true cucumber, but is a member of the melon family. Delicious and different. Also known as 'Painted Serpent.'
	Diva- Thin skin seedless	Especially flavorful when harvested small. Diva's seedless, thin-skinned cukes are distinctly crisp, sweet, and bitter-free. Adapted to open-field production and protected cropping. A fantastic variety for the home garden. Harvest at 5–7".
	Lemon	Small, rounded, pale yellow cucumbers. Pick at 1½–2½" diameter. This versatile cucumber is sweet and flavorful, and doesn't have much of the chemical that makes other cucumbers bitter and hard to digest. Though often served raw, Lemon is also a good pickling cucumber. Specialty market salad item. Note: Very late to begin bearing.
	Marketmore 76	Popular OP variety. Long, slender, dark green cucumbers. The slender, refined "Marketmore look" has long been the standard for slicing cucumbers in the North. 8–9" fruits stay uniformly dark green even under weather stress. Begins bearing late, but picks for a relatively long time.
	Suyo Long	Long-fruited variety popular in China. A sweet-flavored, ribbed fruit growing up to 15" long. Widely adapted, grows well in hot weather, and sets early. Try using this unusual-looking cucumber in salads, for bread-and-butter or mixed vegetable pickles. Excellent eating quality. Bitter-free. Trellis for straight fruits.
<b>Summer Squash</b>		
	Crookneck Early Yellow Squash	Garden favorite. This traditional variety is well known for its buttery flavor and firm texture. Big plants are late to begin bearing, but then yield consistently over a long picking period. Best picked small, 4-5" long. Larger fruits will have a bumpy appearance.
	Nimba Zucchini	A Polish heirloom known for its early, hardy, and shrubby growth, producing elongated, medium-green fruit with dark green flecks and a creamy white, crunchy flesh.
	Rugosa Friulana	A unique, Italian heirloom summer squash known for its "wrinkled of Friuli" appearance, light yellow, warted fruit, and rich, sweet flavor, making it a popular choice in Venetian markets.
	Zucchini Golden	A variety of zucchini characterized by its bright golden-yellow skin and slender, cylindrical fruit, offering a mild, slightly sweet flavor.
<b>Winter Squash</b>		
	Delicata	Unique appearance with cream skin and dark green longitudinal stripes and flecks. Tastes very sweet and skin is tender enough to eat. Excellent for stuffing and baking, even right at harvest! This beautiful strain has gained a nice following in the specialty produce trade. 7–9" long x 3" diam. Avg. weight: 1 1/2–2 lb.
	Honeynut Squash	Popular mini butternut. This distinctive, dark tan butternut has a loyal following among customers, who often ask for it by name. Honeynut is later-maturing, so plant early to achieve best tan coloration. If stored green, fruits will eventually ripen to tan in storage. Developed by the Vegetable Breeding Institute at Cornell University. Avg. weight: 1/2–1 1/2 lb.
	Jester-acorn	Superb flavor in an eye-catching fruit. Oval and tapered at both ends, Jester's distinguishing feature is splashy green, inter-rib striping that contrasts nicely with the ivory background. High-yielding and widely adapted. Short vines. Avg. weight: 1 1/2 lb.
	Waltham Butternut	Larger fruits with small seed cavities and thick, straight, cylindrical necks. Flesh has smooth texture and sweet flavor, particularly after 2 months of storage. This 1970 All-America Selections Winner from Massachusetts is still deservedly the most widely grown, full-size OP butternut. Fruits avg. 9" long.
<b>Pumpkins</b>		
	Winter Luxury Pie	This marvelous small pumpkin has a unique, netted skin. Typical weight is 6–9 lb. Doing double duty, Winter Luxury is not only a gorgeous ornamental, but is also superb for eating. Long vines.
<b>Peppers</b>		
<b>Hot</b>		
	Big Jim	The "Big Jim" pepper, a New Mexico State University cultivar, is known for its large, mild-to-medium heat pods, often used for chiles rellenos, grilling, or stuffing, and can reach up to 1 foot in length.
	Hungarian Wax	This early to mature pepper has incredible yields and is adaptable for challenging growing conditions with cooler summers. Peppers can be harvested at any color of maturity with versatile culinary uses from pickling to frying.
	Jalapeno Brown	A Capsicum annum variety that matures to a rich chocolate brown color, offering a slightly sweeter and smokier flavor than standard green jalapenos, and is known for its mild heat and suitability for stuffing and pickling.
	Long Cayan	Slender, long peppers that turn bright red and are very hot. The 2-foot plants are vigorous and quite productive. Very popular for drying and using as a spice; also used medicinally. This heirloom has been popular for many years.

	Pablano	One of the most popular chilis in Mexico. 3- to 6-inch heart-shaped fruit is usually of gentle heat, at around 2000 Scovilles. Used green, after roasting and peeling, it is the classic pepper for chili rellenos. Dried, the fruit turns a rich dark red-brown and may be ground into an authentic red chili powder. Plants reach 2 feet or so.
	Serrano	Serrano pepper seeds, from the Capsicum annum family, are known for producing small, finger-shaped, hot peppers that mature from green to red, and are easy to grow, with plants typically reaching 24-36 inches tall.
<b>Specialty</b>		
	Criolla de Cocina	Rare heirloom pepper from Nicaragua; High yields of wrinkled peppers; Glossy red skin when mature; Sweet flavor intensifies when cooked; 85 days from transplant.
	Jimmy Nardello	This sweet Italian frying pepper is amazing! Plants bear an abundance of long, thin, tapered rustic peppers that are perfect for whole frying or just about any other application. Fruit holds well on plant, great for extended harvest.
	Lunchbox	Sweet and flavorful orange snack peppers. These beautiful, mini-sized peppers are delicious sautéed, as an addition to salads and, perfect for a healthy snack. Smooth, bright orange fruits average 2 1/2-3" long by 1 1/2" wide.
	Murasaki Purple	The famous and flavorful old Japanese pepper from the Nara Prefecture. Tapered black pods are highly ornamental and look deceptively like a fiery hot pepper. In fact, the beautiful fruit is totally heatless. A new favorite at Baker Creek for its dramatic, dark purple fruit and flowers; even the foliage has a purplish haze. Very productive.
	Paradicsom Alakú Sarga Szentes	Variety originating from Szentes in Hungary, its literal translation gives: "Pepper in the shape of yellow tomato". Small fruit resembling a "mini pumpkin" flattened and ribbed of +/- 50 grams and 6 to 8 cm in diameter. Ripens from green to yellow/orange. Thick and crunchy flesh with excellent flavor. Compact plant of +/- 50 cm. Good mid-season production (+/-75 days). Suitable for pot culture. Withstands cool climates.
	Shishito	Avg. 3-3 1/2" fruits are thin-walled and have no heat. Popular in Japan, where its thin walls make it particularly suitable for tempura. Also very good roasted, in stir-fries, or sautéed. In Asia, the fruits are always cooked green, but they may also be used red. Thinly sliced, the red, slightly sweet fruits are excellent in salads and coleslaws. The plants are large and very productive.
	Txori Xero	A sweet, mild, and thin-skinned heirloom variety from the Basque region of Spain, is prized for its sweet, smoky flavor and is often used for frying, drying to make paprika, or in chorizo seasoning.
<b>Sweet</b>		
	California Wonder Bell	One of the oldest and largest heirloom bell pepper available. First introduced by California growers around 1928. Tall, sturdy plants produce good yields of blocky, thick-walled fruits. A delicious green pepper that ripens to a vibrant red.
	Etiuda-orange bell	Produces large, blocky, thick-walled, and sweet peppers with a vibrant orange color when ripe, known for their ease of growth and high yields.
	King of the North Bell	Early, good-sized peppers of a heavy yielding habit. The variety thrives in the cooler summer weather so prevalent in New England and yields crisp bells, green ripening to red, right up until frost.
	Lipstick	A delectable bright red pimento type pepper that performs exceptionally well in northern climates. These 4-inch-long pointed peppers have super sweet, thick flesh, making them ideal for both eating fresh and cooked. It is a widely adaptable variety that will produce plenty of fruit, even in northern climates with cooler summer weather.
	Mini Bell Mix	A vibrant blend of miniature, sweet bell peppers in various colors like red, yellow, and orange, producing a high yield of snack-sized peppers on compact plants, perfect for containers or small gardens.
	Yellow monster	These behemoth elongated yellow bell peppers can grow 8 inches long by 4 inches wide. They are really sweet, meaty, and wonderful; so pretty after they turn from green to bright sunshine yellow. These are great fresh, fried, or roasted.
<b>Tomatoes</b>		
<b>Slicers</b>		
	Ananas Noire	Indeterminate- The Ananas Noire tomato, also known as "Black Pineapple," is a unique and visually striking heirloom variety. This indeterminate tomato produces large, beefsteak-type fruits that typically weigh between 1 to 1.5 pounds. The tomatoes have a distinctive appearance with a green exterior and vibrant red, yellow, and purple hues inside. The flavor is complex and rich, offering a sweet and slightly tangy taste with hints of citrus.
	Black Krim	Russian heirloom. Black Krim combines bold, smoky flavor and good texture with an unusual appearance. Deep brown/red, 8-16 oz. tomatoes have brown/green shoulders that get darker with more heat and sunlight. High-yielding. Indeterminate.
	Cherokee Purple	Unusual variety with full flavor. Famously rich flavor and texture make this a colorful favorite among heirloom enthusiasts. Medium-large, flattened globe, 8-12 oz. fruits. Color is dusky pink with dark shoulders. Multilocular interior ranges from purple to brown to green. Relatively short vines. Indeterminate.
	Gold Medal	A large, beefsteak tomato variety known for its outstanding flavor, meaty texture, and sweet, tangy taste, typically ripening to a sunset orange with red marbling.

	Green Zebra	A delicious, tangy salad tomato, ripe just as the green fruit develops a yellow blush, accentuating the darker green stripes. The 3–4 oz. fruits are the ideal size for slicing into wedges for salads. Productive over a long season.
	Orange Jazz	Produce large, beefsteak-type tomatoes with a sweet, complex flavor and hints of peach, featuring a unique bright orange skin striped with pale orange and yellow.
	Paul Robeson	This "black" beefsteak tomato is slightly flattened, round, and grows to 4-inches. Its deep, rich colors, a dusky, dark-red, with dark-green shoulders, and red flesh in its center, stand it apart from others. Very flavorful fruits with luscious, earthy, exotic flavors and good acid/sweet balance.
	Vintage Wine	A rare, heirloom variety known for its striking pink and golden-striped, beefsteak tomatoes with a sweet and mild flavor, and it's an indeterminate, potato-leaf plant that produces abundant yields.
<b>Heirlooms</b>		
	Big Rainbow	The fruit are huge, weighing up to 2 pounds, delicious and sweet tasting. These tomatoes are very striking sliced, as the yellow fruit has neon red streaking through the flesh. An heirloom preserved by members of Seed Savers Exchange.
	Dr Wyche's Yellow	Robust flavor. Golden fruits with meatier texture, richer flavor, and fewer blemishes than others in its class. Larger with a more flattened shape than Valencia at 10–16 oz. Gorgeous fruits command attention at market, or on your BLT. Indeterminate.
	Kellogg's Breakfast	A heirloom tomato variety known for its large, bright orange, beefsteak-style fruits with a sweet and tangy flavor, often weighing 1-2 pounds.
	Kentucky Beefsteak	Produces large, globe to oval-shaped, deep orange tomatoes, often weighing up to 2 pounds, with a smooth skin and a balanced, mildly fruity flavor, making them ideal for slicing and sandwiches.
	Large Barred Boar	This regular-leaf tomato grows fairly stocky and not as tall as most other indeterminate varieties. Flattened beefsteak fruit is pink-brown with metallic green stripes and weighs 8-12 ounces. Very meaty pink flesh is very flavorful.
	Mortgage Lifter	A popular heirloom tomato known for its large size (often over 2 pounds), meaty texture, and rich, sweet flavor, with a history of being grown for its high saleability and ability to help farmers pay off debts.
	Orange Accordion	The Orange Accordion tomato is a unique heirloom variety known for its vibrant, ruffled, orange-colored fruits that can reach up to 20 ounces and have a sweet, fruity flavor, making them suitable for sauces, slicing, and stuffing.
Determinate	Purple Reign (Det)	Tidy and compact 3-foot tall plants are smothered in purple beefsteak tomatoes with a beautifully balanced flavor. The fruit average 6-12 ounces and are ideal for slicing or sandwiches and can also double as a nice sauce tomato.
<b>Cherry</b>		
	A Grappoli D'Inverno	This is the "winter grape" tomato of old Italy, where farmers would hang the fruit-covered vines and they would stay fresh well into the winter. They also dry perfectly and resemble little Roma tomatoes. The flavorful fruit is delicious and great for snacking, fresh or dried.
	Blueberries	A unique, indigo-purple cherry tomato variety, known for their high levels of anthocyanin (the same antioxidant found in blueberries) and a slightly tart, sweet flavor. They are indeterminate, meaning they continue to produce fruit throughout the season, and are known for their prolific yields.
	Blush Tiger	An heirloom-style, indeterminate tomato variety with a golden-yellow base and pink and red streaks, resulting in elongated, grape-sized fruits with a sweet, fruity, and balanced flavor.
	Chadwick Cherry	The delicious, sweet flavor makes this 1-ounce cherry popular with home gardeners. Large vines set huge yields and are disease-resistant.
	Lucky Tiger	The elongated 2-inch fruit comes in stunning, jewel-toned shades of green and red, with hints of gold. This tomato gets top marks for flavor: tangy, super sweet, and complex with tropical notes and balanced acidity. Lucky Tiger is well suited for both greenhouse and field growing.
	Napa Chardonnay	A tomato variety created by Brad Gates, producing an abundance of pale yellow, almost see-through cherry tomatoes that ripen early and continue to produce until frost.
	Sun Gold	Exceptionally sweet, bright tangerine-orange cherry tomatoes leave everyone begging for more. Vigorous plants start yielding early and bear right through the season. Tendency to split precludes shipping, making these an exclusively fresh-market treat. The taste can't be beat. 15–20 gm. fruits. Indeterminate.
	Yellow Pear	Very sweet, 1.5-inch yellow, pear-shaped fruit has a mild flavor, and is great for fresh eating or for making tomato preserves. These are very productive plants that are easy to grow.
<b>Paste/Sauce</b>		
	Jersey Devil (Indet)	A unique, pepper-shaped fruit in vivid crimson color from New Jersey, this variety is perfect for bright red, robust sauces as well as for fresh eating. The tomatoes average 6 inches in length and are very meaty with few seeds. A later maturing variety, but so worth the wait, as the flavor is incredible and the yields are high.
Determinate	Martino's Roma (Det)	Fantastic yields of richly flavorful plum-shaped tomatoes, on compact plants that require very little staking! Resistant to early blight, reliable for home or market gardens! The paste-type fruit weighs in at 2-3 ounces, dry-fleshed and very meaty with few seeds. Great for sauces, salsas and pastes.
